There are still many prejudices linked to the world of disability, particularly when it comes to affection, sexuality or parenting. There are many women with disabilities (WwDs) who are advised against motherhood and who feel judged daily for their desire for autonomy. The project aims to identify the barriers that PwDs encounter in gynaecological-obstetric services and break down sexist stereotypes.

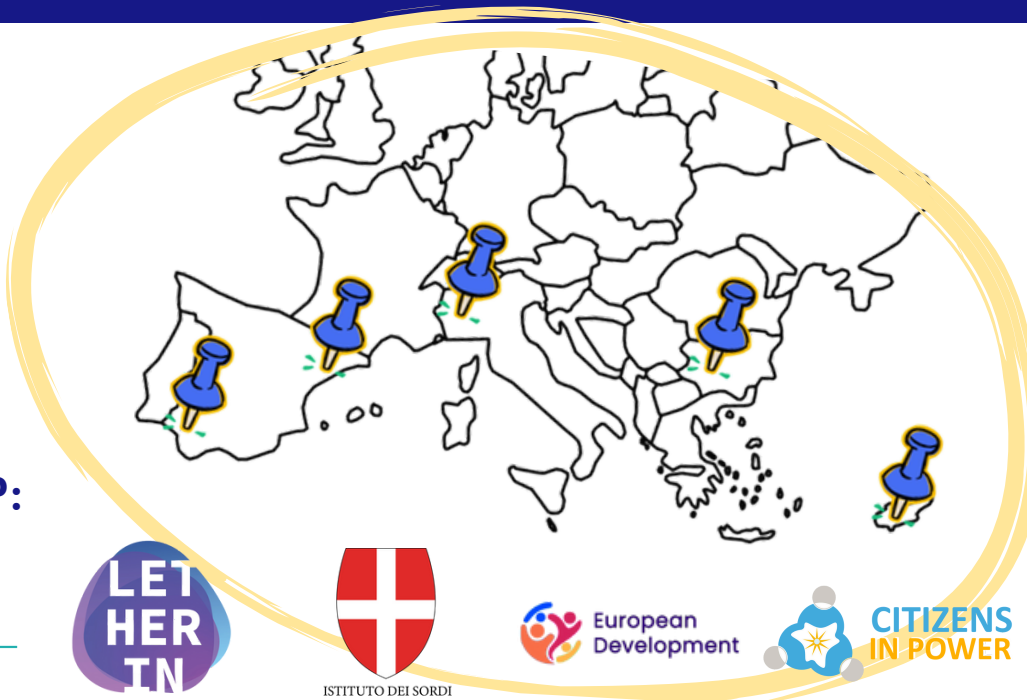

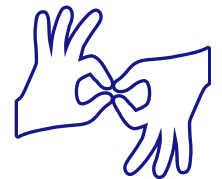
In MoMs project, each partner involved a group of women/mothers with disabilities and a group of healthcare/education professionals.
